Member Benefits:

1. Help develop minor league hockey in Southeast Texas and draw players to this region.
2. Special invitations to "Members Only" events - meet players and team staff.
3. Involvement in road trips
4. Obtain club and team updates via newsletter, website, and monthly meetings.
5. Speakers from team or other hockey insiders at meetings.
6. Meet and interact with other hockey fans.

Member Communication:

1. Meetings and events will be communicated via email when an email address is provided. Otherwise, phone calls will be made to those members who do not have or do not wish to provide the TWBC with an email address.
2. Meeting and event dates and times will be announced as soon as details are available.

Member Obligations:

First, the Texas Wildcatters Booster Club (TWBC) is not a "fan club" in the traditional sense of the word. We consider ourselves a service organization whose primary purpose is to promote and support the Texas Wildcatters hockey team including the players, coaching, support staff, and front office / management. We work to raise funds to improve the quality of life of the players on and off the ice. We insure that new players have a great "first impression" of the Golden Triangle and its fan base. We cannot accomplish our purpose without the active involvement of every single member. Before you sign up, please be aware that there are obligations that accompany membership. We expect that as a member of the club you will share in the responsibilities and we are flexible enough to accommodate your schedule. When everyone pitches in the time obligation is minimal.

1. Support the missions and purpose of the TWBC as listed in the Bylaws.
2. Constructively contribute to and participate in its programs and activities.
3. Regularly attend membership meetings
4. Sign up for and participate in at least one committee.
5. Share knowledge, ideas and talents.
6. Respect and guard the privacy and dignity of the players, coaches, and staff and their families on and off the ice.

Types of Memberships:

1. **Adult Membership** - Adult membership may be conferred on all persons eighteen (18) years of age, who is a member in good standing will include full voting rights for all motions, proposals and elections.
2. **Family Membership** - Family membership may be conferred on parent(s) and all children ages twelve (12) - twenty (20) years old living at home and enrolled in school. Each person eighteen (18) years of age or older in a family membership who is a member in good standing shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of membership, including voting rights. Children ages twelve (12) - seventeen (17) in a family membership shall have the rights and privileges of membership limited to Article III.d.5-8 of the Bylaws. The privilege to participate in TWBC trips by members under the age of eighteen (18) is restricted, with attendance on such trips required to be under the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian.
3. **Out-of-Town Membership** - Out of town membership may be conferred on any person eighteen (18) or older living outside Texas. Out of town members shall have the rights and privileges of membership except the right to hold office or the right to vote in any matters.

____ **Newsletter / Website** - Writing articles on events, players, road games, etc. Providing photos of events and road games.

____ **Entertainment** - Planning meetings before events, staffing events, taking tickets, keeping events organized, etc.

____ **"911 Team"** - On call to provide rides for players, errands for team, etc.

____ I am willing to help as needed, whenever a committee is shorthanded.
